OSO Comments

Customer surveys rate One Stop Services as average or above average, but the low survey completion rate limits insights. Common complaints include technology issues and staff responsiveness, although feedback about individual staff members is generally positive, highlighting their helpfulness and friendliness.

OSO Recommendations:

- Increase Survey Completion-train staff to encourage customers to complete surveys, provide paper surveys, market surveys with flyers.
- Provide recommendations to the State Board about changing the technology and simplifying.
- Reward or recognizing staff that are mentioned in surveys.
