Ryan reported that all expenditures were on track for all programs. Also, he stated that to date the van utilized for the Burlington Correctional Facility had delivered approximately 900 rides for clients to travel to and from work sites.

TITLE II AEL UPDATE

Mulch reported that staffing is currently back on track and classes will be starting again in Keokuk soon.

TITLE III IWD UPDATE

Farley reported that the state of Iowa unemployment rate is at 2.5%, and that all four county rates in Region 16 have declined in the last month. She also reported that currently there are just over 1,000 open positions on Iowajobs.org. In addition, she stated that the Future Ready Iowa Summit was a great success with over 100 attendees.

She also announced several upcoming events including a hiring event for ABB who currently has over 30 openings on second shift. On November 9th they will be holding their annual veterans' lunch at Iowa WORKS and all board members are invited to attend. Also, an open house/job fair will be held on November 15th from 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. at the Mt. Pleasant Correctional Facility.

TITLE IV VR/IDB UPDATE

Whalen reported that the state employment outcomes for vocational rehabilitation were at 2097, an increase from last year.
